#### Please note:

- 1. All attendees will have assigned seating.
- 2. You may create a group from 2 to 8 people for this event. Maximum of 8 per table.
- 3. For reservations with fewer than 8 people, your table will be completed with other members.

There are two ways for you to make table reservations for your group:

- 1) The Head Person for your group collects all the checks (made out to Newcomers Club in the correct amount) and lists what each person wants for lunch either on the lower left hand corner of each check or on a group list. Paperclip the checks together and place in an envelope. Or,
- 2) The Head Person for your group may write one check for everyone in the group and provide a list of attendees along with each of their lunch requests.

# Please ensure that each person's meal choice is noted on the checks or on your list of tablemates.


