A Note about Luncheon Prices

I am sure that all of you have noticed that food prices are skyrocketing. Even eggs are up to \$6 a dozen. We have been trying very hard to get the best choices and value for your dollar at the luncheons. When you see the price we are charging, please remember that it not only includes the entrée but the beverage station (cheapest iced tea I've found is \$2.75), dessert, tax of 7.5%, and a service charge of 18-20%.

We have been fortunate that Alta Sierra has not charged us a room rental fee since we returned there in 2022. Unfortunately, that has ended, and we now will be charged a room rental fee. Both Lake of the Pines and Lake Wildwood were, and still are, charging us a room rental fee.

It is always the goal to break even on each event. Our luncheons are not meant to be profitable, but we never want to be over budget, so there is a slight cushion built in. Did you know that we bought our own tablecloths and our Newcomers President takes them home and washes them herself? That is how keen we are on giving you the best price possible.
